"The Dissemination Project: Bringing Awareness and Acceptance to the Field of ABA in an Unconventional Way"

## **Abstract**

Applied Behavior Analysis, is a discipline that has grown at exponential rates in the past decade. However, we are still considered a minority discipline in comparison to other sciences and being an expert in Behavior Analysis is not enough to change how others view our field.
